INSTRUCTIONS TO ICPC 2013 CONTESTANTS REGARDING TRANSPORTATION TO BENGALURU SITE

(Updated on 12 December – updates in red color)

- Pick-up facility from Bengaluru city railway station will be provided to contestants arriving on 16th, 17th, and 18th ~~and 19th~~ December 2013. Contestants are requested to come out of the platform and assemble in front of the advanced reservation counter building (near the exit to the majestic bus station side). Student volunteers will be there with placards to guide the contestants to board into Amrita university bus.
- Drop facility to Bengaluru city railway station will be arranged for contestants leaving on 19th, 20th and 21st December 2013.
- Contestants arriving before 17th December and departing after 21st December are requested to make their own arrangements for their travel to and from the Bengaluru site.
- We will not be able to provide pick-up or drop from Airport or Yeswanthpur railway station. You are requested to make your own arrangements to reach the campus. Those arriving at Yeswanthpur railway station can reach Bangalore City Railway Station (distance - 7kms) to avail the ICPC contest pickup facility. Frequent public buses are available from Yeswanthpur railway station to Majestic – KBS bus station (just opposite the city railway station)
- Contestants arriving at other locations are kindly requested to travel to City Railway Station and board the college bus.
- Since we have a large number of contestants arriving at different times of the day, pick up will be at specified times. A tentative schedule for pick up from Bengaluru city railway station is given below. The schedule will be fine tuned once all the participants furnish their arrival details.

Bengaluru Site Information

The onsite contest at Bengaluru is conducted at Amrita School of Engineering, Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham, Bengaluru campus. It is located just off the Koramangala, HSR Layout and Sarjapura Road areas. It is about 18 kilometers from Kempagowda Bus Station (KBS) and Bengaluru City Railway station.

How To Reach:

By Bus: Our campus is about 18 kilometers from Kempagowda Bus Station (KBS) which is adjacent to Bengaluru City Railway station. The Campus is located in south Bengaluru on a road connecting Sarjapur Road and Hosur Road and is about 2 kilometers from Kaikondranahalli bus stop on Sarjapur Road. BMTC busses 342 F (from KBS – also known as Majestic), 342 A, 342 B, 342 C and 342 D (from City Market) pass through Kaikondranahalli. Buses 341 B from City Market and 340 L from Majestic pass through the college campus.

By Air : Bengaluru International Airport at Devanahalli is located about 50kms away from the Campus. Metered taxis can be used to come to the campus, which may cost around Rs. 1000/-. Alternatively one can avail the services of Bengaluru International Airport Shuttle service (BIAS) (More information at url: <http://www.mybmtc.com/airportservices>). Take the airport shuttle BIAS-8 and get down at Sarjapura cross. Amrita is about 4.5 kms from Sarjapura cross. Auto charges from Sarjapura cross to Amrita will be approximately Rs 80/-

By Train: The campus is located about 18 kilometers from Bengaluru city railway station and about 25 kilometers from Yeswanthpur railway station. Most of the trains bound for Bengaluru terminate at city railway station. However, there are a few trains which do not touch this station but terminate at Yeswanthpur railway station.
